P-130 Rust Inhibitive Primer

BASIC USES & DESCRIPTION:

P-130 is a high quality, water-based, single-component, plasticizer-free acrylic primer. P-130 is designed for application over metal roof surfaces to prevent rust growth and prime the surface to be coated. P-130 can be applied with spray equipment, roller, or brush. Spray application is preferred.

LIMITATIONS & PRECAUTIONS:

Surface must be completely clean and dry prior to application of P-130. P-130 should not be applied if there is any moisture on the roof surface or if there is risk of precipitation before product can fully cure. This is a water-based product and requires evaporation to cure. The curing process requires at least 6 hours. More time will be required in environments with low temperatures or high humidity as these factors slow the curing process.

APPLICATION:

P-130 may be applied with spray equipment, roller, or brush onto a clean, dry surface. Spray application is preferred. For equipment specifications, please contact Progressive Materials. P-130 should not be applied if the ambient temperature is below 50°F or could fall below 32°F within 6 hours of application. P-130 should be applied at a rate of 1 gallon per 200 square feet, or 4-5 dry mils.

Pressure washing is required on metal surfaces showing signs of oxidation. Do not leave product exposed to elements for more than 48 hours to prevent weathering and dirt pick-up that will compromise adhesive performance.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE:

P-130 is water-based and therefore is not freeze-thaw stable. Store material indoors between 40°F and 70°F. Shelf life of product is 12 months from date of manufacture.

PACKAGING SIZES:

P-130 Rust-Inhibitive Primer is available in 5-gallon and 55-gallon containers.
