PM Customer Training Options

- 1. Equipment Only Training (\$1,000)** - This includes a ½ day of on-site, equipment-only training.
- 2. Rooftop/Jobsite Spray Training (\$2,500)** - This is a 2-day field training. This includes a big rig set up, tear down, and rebuild demonstration, and an on-roof spray technique tutorial. Your team will interact with our designated trainer and be able to ask questions in real time, while applying the silicone.
- 3. PM Plant Spray Training** - This option is 1 day of equipment and roof training held at the PM office in New Albany, Indiana. Associated travel costs are the responsibility of the contractor. Training is provided by PM at no charge.

Preparation for Training

In order for the rooftop training to be successful, the roof must be completely prepped and ready for the final topcoat at the time of the training. This ensures that the training process can start first thing, allowing more hands-on time with the equipment.

In addition to having the roof prepped and ready for coating, the contractor must have the following items at the jobsite the morning of the training:

- A minimum of 20 gallons of PM's MS 550 Mineral Spirits
- A good drill and a mixer capable of mixing up a drum
- 2 adjustable wrenches and a set of standard size Allen wrenches for pump set up
- Rubber gloves
- A large tarp to set equipment and material on to protect the jobsite
- Any other material typically needed to complete a PM silicone roof restoration
